Dear Mr. Morrison:

On behalf of Evergy Kansas Central, Inc. (f/k/a Westar Energy, Inc.), in accordance with Title 40 Code of Federal Regulations (40 CFR) § 257.94(e)(3) of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Federal Coal Combustion Residuals (CCR) Rule (40 CFR § 257 and 261), Haley & Aldrich, Inc. has prepared this notification that an assessment monitoring program has been established for the Bottom Ash Pond (inactive) at the Jeffrey Energy Center. A statistically significant increase (SSI) over background levels for one or more constituents listed in Appendix III has been determined for the CCR unit. Per 40 CFR § 257.94(e)(2), a successful demonstration that a source other than the CCR unit caused the SSI over background levels was not completed within 90 days of the SSI determination, and the assessment monitoring program was initiated. The assessment monitoring program has been established to meet the requirements of 40 CFR § 257.95.
